

Terms and Conditions for borrowing Carlow County Council's Clothes Swap Kit

- Definition of the "Kit" includes clothes rails, starter pack of adult clothing, chalk board and chalk pens, a mirror, tokens, mannequin and hangers.
- The Clothes Swap Kit is and remains the property of Carlow County Council.
- If you notice any problems with the Kit, please report it to Carlow County Council during the loan period.
- Borrowers are responsible for the Kit from the moment they collect it, until it is delivered back. They are responsible to protect the equipment from loss or damage. Equipment must only be used for its designed purpose and within its specifications. You will be required to reimburse Carlow County Council for the cost of any equipment damaged and/or lost.
- Borrowers must agree to the terms in the agreement by completing the Loan Agreement Form. Any personal details collected on the form will only be shared with Carlow County Council for the purpose of arranging the loan for the agreed duration of the clothes swap event.
- The borrower must satisfy themselves that any Health and Safety Statement, insurance provision, and Risk Assessment Plan for their event is satisfactory. Sole responsibility lies with the borrower/event organiser.
- Carlow County Council bears no responsibility for the management of this event or activity.
- Carlow County Council bears no responsibility for the management of safety for the duration of this activity.
- The borrower must comply with Health & Safety legislation, the Health & Welfare at Work Act 2005, all regulations made thereunder, and all other relevant legislation, regulations and approved Codes of Practice, to ensure the safe running of this activity.
- The applicant has responsibility to ensure adherence with all public health legislation, regulations, guidelines and requirements.
